Years 3 and 4 Swimming – Thursdays

From next week, each Thursday, pupils in Class 2 will attend a swimming lesson at the pool at Brandon Primary School. Pupils will be escorted by their class teacher and support staff and will travel by private coach.

Your child needs to bring a one piece swimming costume or trunks (not boxer style bottoms), a swimming cap and a towel. Pupils may bring a pair of goggles, if they wish. No other equipment should be brought.

A reminder that the wearing of jewellery is not permitted in school and pupils attending school wearing jewellery will not be allowed to swim.

Breakfast Club – from 8am

Just a reminder that, Breakfast Club will be running from 8am, from Monday 06 September. The cost is £3 for one child, £5 for two children and £7.50 for three children and £10 for four children (from the same household).

Booking is not required and the club is open to all year groups.

Please put monies owing in a marked envelope and send this into school with your child.

A member of staff will collect the children from the main gate at 8am. Any pupils arriving after this time should make their way to the main entrance.

A member of staff will be supervising this area and will be registering the children attending.
