Start of School Mass

The whole school will attend Mass at 9:30am on Monday 13 September, to mark the start of the new school year. **All are**



welcome, but visitors to the church must wear a face covering, unless exempt and will be required to provide contact details, in keeping with Test and Trace. These details will be collected by one of the ushers, at the rear of the church.

At this Mass, we will give a particular welcome to those pupils new to the school.

Tea Club – Every Day – Monday to Friday

From Monday 13 September, we will be providing supervision for pupils from 3:15pm, until 5pm. Staff and a sports coach will supervise pupils



eating a tea-time snack, **brought from home**. Pupils will also be engaged in a range of activities.

If a place is required, it is essential that you book your child into this club. We ask you to book via email or telephone, through the school office, no later than 10am on the Friday before.

The club will run for a minimum of half a term. We hope that it proves financially viable, to enable this to be an ongoing service.

The cost is £5 per day for one child, and £4 per day for children from the same household and pupils may attend all, or part, of the week.

Breakfast Club – from 8am

Just a reminder that, Breakfast Club is running from 8am. The cost is £3 for one child, £5 for two children and £7.50 for three children and £10 for four children (from the same household).

Booking is not required and the club is open to all year groups.

Please put monies owing in a marked envelope and send this into school with your child.

A member of staff will collect the children from the main gate at 8am. Any pupils arriving after this time should make their way to the main entrance.

A member of staff will be supervising this area and will be registering the children attending.
